## 1238. Traffic And Parking

At the last meeting, in her absence Cllr Cheney was asked to talk with the Gait & Ramblers regarding putting up notices in their establishment about parking. However, she was not really sure what was required. Cllr Burley explained that the council was requesting that the car park at the top of the village is highlighted to customers at the Gait & the Ramblers Rest.

Cllr Willoughby spoke to highways, they have no objection to us putting up signs. The council need to submit a proposal to include the wording, the shape, size and number required. There is also a possibility that funding may be available. It was suggested that the wall on the Rambler's Rest by the pinch point would be a good place to put a sign. Cllr Cheney to discuss with Angela Sissons.

Cllr Burley has made some progress on possible funding to expand the top carpark

#### 1239.Highways

Cllr Francis reported that all gravel road repairs done by East Riding Council was washed out during the recent rain storms. In addition, water has exposed an old iron sign base on the parking verge just north of the church. Cllr Francis will contact East Riding Council and report the problem and in the meantime Cllr Willoughby will attack it with a lump hammer, to try and preventing damage to vehicles tyres.


