The Parish Council are organising a celebration of the 80th Anniversary of D Day on 6th June 2024.


The event starts with a Fish and Chip supper available at The Gait Inn (please book directly with them) to celebrate national Fish & Chip Day. $\pounds 1.00$ per meal will be equally divided between four charities: The Royal Navy, Merchant Navy Associations, Royal Air Force Benevolent Fund and the ABF The Soldiers Charity. This is part of the National Federation of Fish Friers encouraging outlets to help sell 156,000 portions of fish and chips on the 6th June representing one portion for each Allied troop that landed in Normandy by sea and air on D-Day.

There will then be a torchlight parade up to the Swineridge View Beacon for it to be lit at 9.15pm, linking with others across the United Kingdom.
