## East Riding and Hull Joint Minerals Local Plan Revised Preferred Approach Consultation

Once adopted, the Joint Minerals Local Plan (JMLP) will provide the main planning policies for the consideration and determination of planning applications for minerals development. It will also allocate a range of sites to provide for sufficient aggregates (those minerals used in building and construction industries) to meet expected demand over the plan period to 2032.

A Revised Preferred Approach version of JMLP (a full version of the proposed plan) will be published for public consultation on **Monday 23**<sup>rd</sup> **May, 2016**.

The closing date for responses on the draft plan is Monday 11th July 2016.
